ARE YOU READY TO FUNDRAISE???

There are lots of ways to defer the cost of dance. Throughout the year, we will hold several fundraisers, most of which will raise funds specifically for your dancer's account. None of the fundraisers are required and you are welcome to participate in as many or as few as you wish. Please watch the FWSOD Facebook page as fundraising information will ALWAYS be posted there. Follow ups will be sent through emails in parent portal.



For planning, here is a list of what has been scheduled thus far. We will be adding some fundraisers throughout the fall, so this is not a comprehensive list.

Valley Hall Bingo – Weekend volunteers needed to cover day and night games (you can pick). Earn dance credit of \$75 per volunteer shift. Accounts are credited monthly.

Lil' Caesar Pizza Kits – Sale begins on September 13th and Orders will be due on October 11th with delivery of frozen product the week of October 25th. To participate, you must be available to pick up when delivered. Dancer to earn \$5-\$7 per item sold.

Butter Braids – This was a new fundraiser for us last year, and it was a hit. We are offering this in late October – November to ensure holiday delivery. Folks love Butter Braids, so mark your calendar and watch for details. Dancer earns approximately \$8 per item sold.

Flower Sales – Seasonal Flower Sales in Fall (Mums), Winter (Poinsettias), Spring (Colorful Baskets). Amount for account will vary based on seasonal price of flowers.

Gift Card Giveaway – Contribute a \$25 gift card and sale tickets for a variety of store gift cards. Generally, we have about \$350-\$400 worth of gift cards. Tickets generally sell \$5 per ticket and dancers receive 100% of profit from ticket sales.

Group Fundraisers On occasion, we will partner with area businesses and restaurants to have a night to promote FWSOD and receive a portion of profits from that restaurant. Please be on the lookout for these nights.




Showstopper Competition March 18-20 in Cocord, NC

Solos, Duets, & Trios

You must be approved on an individual basis by the studio and a teacher before getting started. Forms are available online under our parent resources tab. You will not be able to start any solos or duets before this is completed. First year team members may not do any extra routines unless they are transferring from another studio team. Bitty prime members may only do one, bitty elite may do up to two, preteen prime and select students may do up to three and all other team members are unlimited based on availability and ability.

Optional Competitions

Those who wish to participate in Optional Competitions for their solos, duets, or trios can find the form on our website under the parent resources and ensemble resources links. As a reminder, teachers will not be in attendance at these competitions.

Forms must be turned in **two weeks before the competition deadline** to allow time for the office to get your child registered. We are excited to see everyone participate in as many competition events as they desire. However, when forms are turned in last minute or past the deadline, it causes major issues within the office. Forms turned in two weeks before the competition deadline will receive no extra fee other than the competition fees charged. However, if your form is turned in later, we will charge your account an additional \$10 administrative fee. We hope you can understand the extra work that we incur when having to ask competitions for exceptions or to reopen registrations that were already completed.
