Your Ensemble Account

Your ensemble account is the main account that your child will use for all fees and charges associated with the ensemble. Checks written to this account should be made payable to Floyd Ward Ensemble and not to the studio. Please do not confuse this account with your tuition which is separate. However, those

paying with credit card may pay both at the same time in parent portal.

Currently, your child's membership fees of \$60 are due. If you had a credit or debt from last season, it is still in your account. Debts need to be taken care of within the first month of class to avoid suspension from the teams.

Funds in your ensemble account can be paid for with help from fundraising & sponsorships. In return for their monetary donation, sponsors receive recognition in the annual recital program. The sponsorship letter can be found under the parent resources section of our website.

Jackets, Bags, T-shirts & Jewelry!

All ensemble members are required to have a FWSOD ensemble jacket to wear to competitions on stage over their costumes at award ceremonies. Many of the dancers wear them the entire weekend of competition in support of our school and their teammates.

All ensemble members are also required to have the ensemble t-shirt. We will be using the same design as last year since we do not yet know what the year will hold. Many parents choose to purchase these as well to wear at competition in support of our school and our students.

Please check with your child's ensemble teacher to see which pieces of jewelry will be needed for your child's dance. If you have not been on teams in the past or if you have lost yours, you will need to order new jewelry.

Dance bags with our team logo are also available, but not mandatory.

All items can be ordered by turning in the form to the left into the secretary no later than October 31.

Solos, Duets, & Trios

You must be approved on an individual basis by the studio and a teacher before getting started. Forms are available online under our parent resources tab. You will not be able to start any solos or duets before this is completed. First year team members may not do any extra routines. Bitty prime members may only do one, bitty elite may do up to two, preteen prime and select students may do up to three and all other team members are unlimited based on availability and ability.

Your Parent Portal

Your parent portal is now live at floydwarddance.com. Within the portal you can enroll students for classes, see your child's schedule, look at your account, change contact information, view any emails that were sent out, and more. This will be our new main means of communication with our dance family. Please check in with the secretary your first day back to make sure that your email on file is correct. Otherwise, you cannot sign in.

Directions for Setting up Parent Portal:

- 1. Make sure the email we have is accurate
- 2. Access the parent portal via the link at the top of the page at floydward-dance.com
- 3. Enter Parent Portal
- 4. Type in your email address and select forgot my password
- 5. A link will be sent to your email to use as a temporary password
- 6. At the top of the portal once you log in, select I want to "Change My Password" from the drop down options to change your password to something you will remember.

Also note that a \$5 convenience fee will be posted to everyone's account each month. Those who choose to pay with check or cash will have that fee deleted.

In parent portal, your account appears as one and you can make a single credit card payment to cover both. However, check and cash payments will still need to be separated because of the way we are processing items at the studio.
